Admissions and Application Procedure

Admissions

One form is to be completed by an ordained minister, preferable by the pastor of the church where the applicant attends. The persons responsible for completing the form should mail it directly to the college.

<u>Photo</u>: A photograph is required for all applicants for identification purposes. This photograph must be included with each application.
